3. Registration of spotted horses with ASMH, a division of AGMH:

Spotted horses will be accepted for ASMH registration under the following guidelines and regulations:

a) Any spotted horse that is **not** registered with SMHA, MPHA, or KNGHA **and** exhibits less than 50% Heritage Ancestry, proven by DNA, must provide a video under saddle to be reviewed by the Trainers and Exhibitors Committee before registration will be approved. The Committee may approve, deny, or require another video. If denied, an appeal can be made, whereupon a second denial will be final. In lieu of a video, horses may be presented for examination in person by the Trainers and Exhibitors Committee.

b) ASMH certificates will be issued in the same fashion as AGMH regarding Heritage Ancestry, i.e More than 75% Heritage Ancestry – gold with star; More than 50% Heritage Ancestry – gold; 50% Heritage Ancestry – silver; Less than 50% Heritage Ancestry – green.

c) In order to qualify for registration as ASMH, offspring of a registered ASMH horse must prove at least 50% Heritage Ancestry; such proof to be made by DNA through a sharing registry.

(“UMH”) or a UMH Superhorse Award; or an International Grand Championship awarded by a Designated Mountain Horse Registry or Sam Tuttle Award. 5. DNA Requirements: Any horse registered with one of the Designated Mountain Horse Registries **that has agreed to share** DNA results with AGMH through the U. of KY (RMHA,MPHA, KINGHA) is not required to provide DNA or blood-typing for AGMH registration. **Fillies/Mares** or **Colts/Stallions** registered solely with a **non-sharing registry** or eligible to be registered with one of the Designated Mountain Horse Registries (but not yet registered), as well as any horses resulting from cross-breeding within the Designated Mountain Horse Registries (but not registered with one of those registries), **must provide DNA submitted through a sharing registry. Any declared Heritage Ancestry parentage** (defined as verifiable RMHA and/or MPHA lineage) must be **proven by DNA** before an AGMH Certificate can be issued. Proof of parentage is not required to any non-Heritage Ancestry parent(s). In the case of no Heritage Ancestry parentage, **ID/baseline only DNA** is required. **Geldings** must provide DNA for I.D. purposes, and must prove parentage to any Heritage Ancestry declared. If DNA is required and not yet on file through a sharing registry, a DNA kit can be purchased from AGMHA for \$43.00. To expedite registration, you can opt to pull 20-30 tail hairs, including the root bulbs, cut the sample to 3-4" inches, tape it to a piece of paper with the horse's name clearly labeled, and place in a paper envelope (not a plastic baggie). Send the sample along with the \$43.00 fee to AGMHA at the address below, and we will submit it with the proper paperwork to U. KY. **All DNA reports obtained through AGMH/ASMH will be made available (upon request) to any of the Designated Mountain Horse Registries.**
